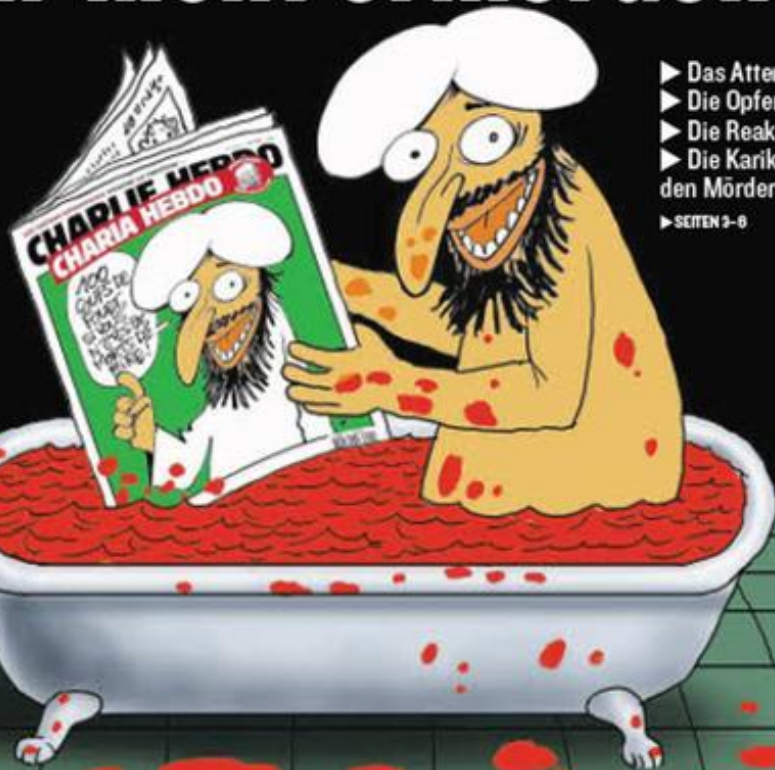

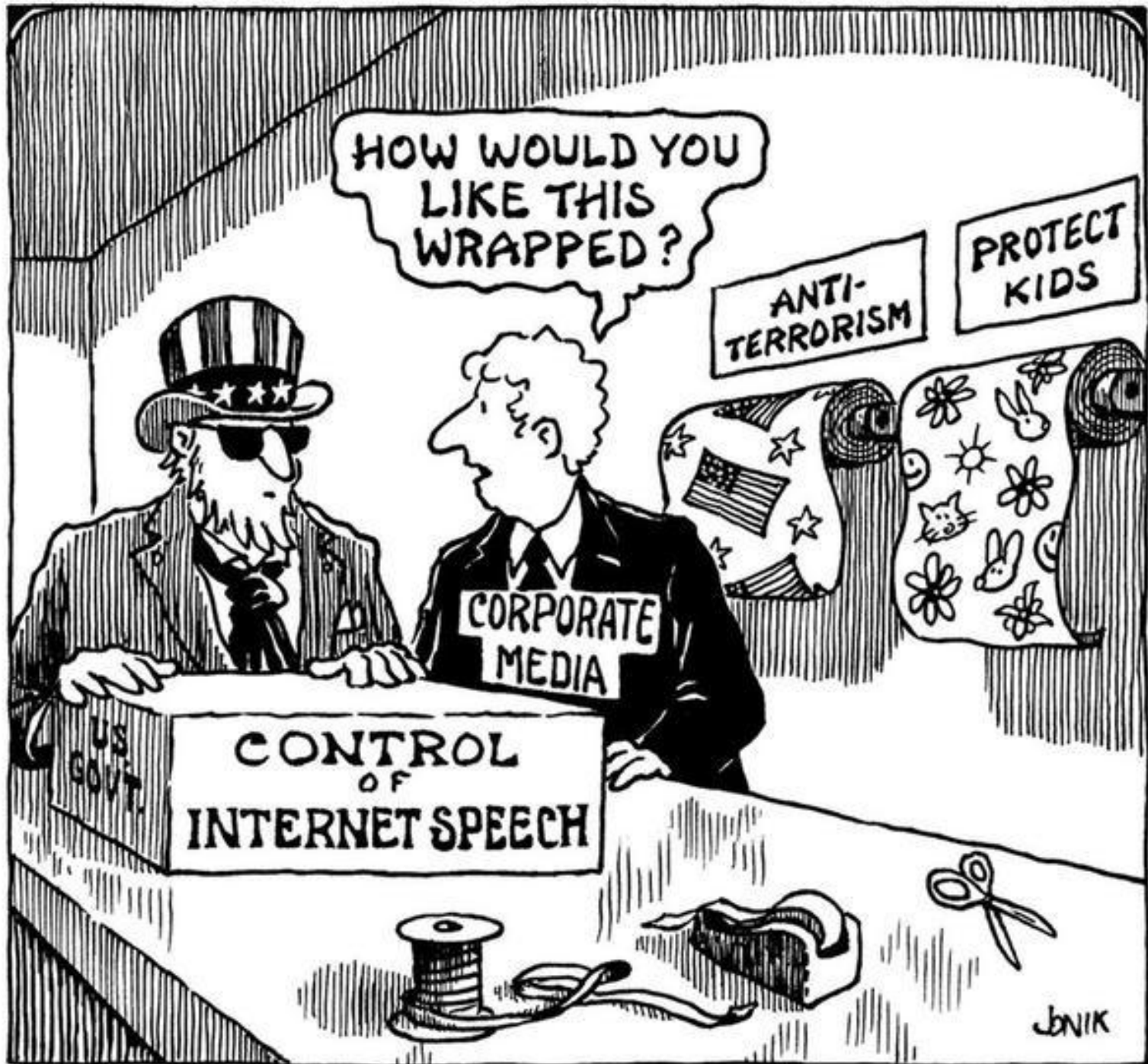

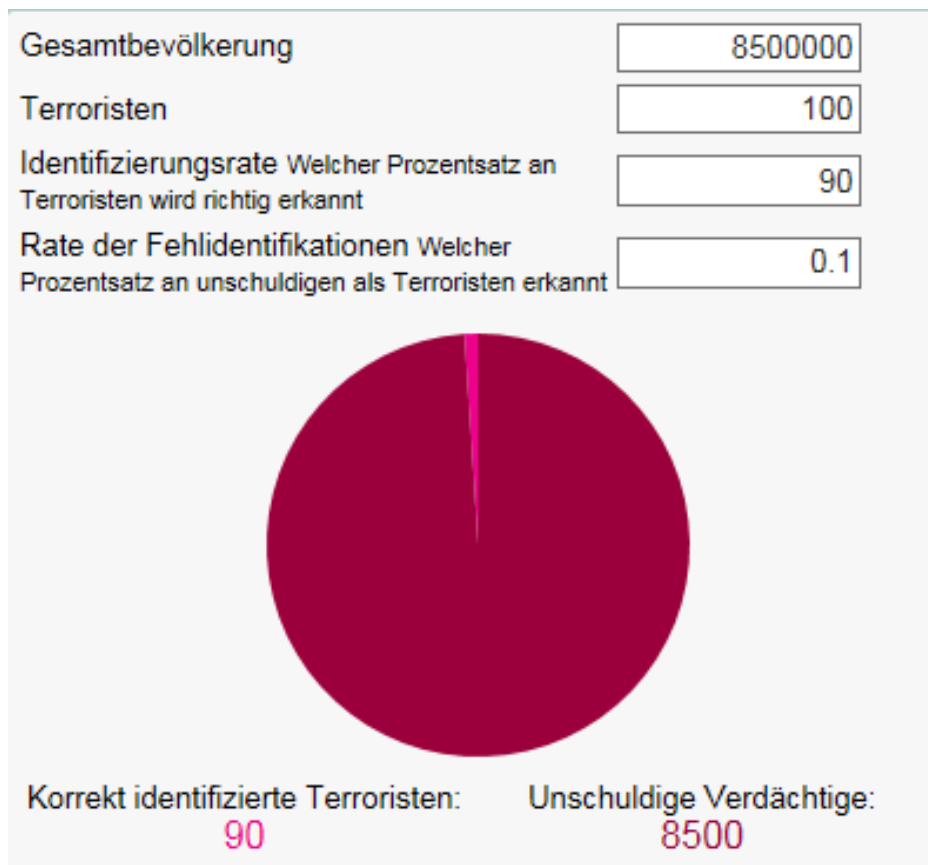

PEN's International
Survey of Writers
January 5, 2014

PEN free expression,

A. Writers living in both Free and Not Free countries have avoided writing or speaking on a particular topic, or have seriously considered it, due to fear of government surveillance, including:

*34% of writers in
Free countries*

*44% of writers in
Partly Free countries*

61% of writers in Not Free countries

B. Writers living in both Free and Not Free countries have curtailed or avoided activities on social media, or seriously considered it, due to fear of government surveillance, including:

42% of writers in Free countries

46% of writers in Partly Free countries

53% of writers in Not Free countries


In comparison, 40% of U.S. writers surveyed by PEN in October 2013 reported curtailing or avoiding activities on social media, or seriously considering doing so.¹⁷

In next week's State of the Union address, President Obama will propose [new laws against hacking](#) that could make either *retweeting* or *clicking on* the above (fictional) link illegal. The new laws make it a felony to intentionally access *unauthorized information* even if it's been posted to a public website. The new laws make it a felony to traffic in information like passwords, where "trafficking" includes posting a link.
